

He was released in 1993; no current observable political activity, [redacted] a retired teacher, who was detained by the Military Intelligence Branch in Deir Ezzor for 8 months on counts of joining the suspected rightist group; he was detained in 2011 by the very same branch on counts of incitement and participation in anti-state demonstrations in Al-Mayadeen city; he was released a week later; [redacted] a neutral schoolteacher.

- It has not been established that his immediate family members or relatives has ever been politically detained or wanted.
- Prior record: no political prior record

5- [redacted], his mother's name [redacted] born in [redacted] and resides in the same place. [redacted] is a Syrian Arab, single. Education: bachelor's degree in medicine, occupation: medical doctor in Ukraine. Financial status: moderate, original class: peasant, normal public relations, good mannered with a good social reputation among his acquaintances.

= Politically neutral while inside the country; it has not been established that he, his immediate family members, or relatives have anything to do with the negative or opposing political organizations and faith-based groups; nor had it been established that any of his relatives took part in the demonstrations.

-Religious activity: normal; not a follower of a specific religious denomination

Born in Deir Ezzor city, studied and graduated from its high schools. In 1998, he left for Ukraine to study medicine and obtained the bachelor's degree. Frequented the country until 2000, and never came back ever since.

= information indicate that the above individual took part in the anti-state demonstration in front of the Syrian embassy in Ukraine.

-His father is a retired employee from Euphrates Oil Company, neutral.; his mother is a housewife – neutral. His brothers: [redacted] works at the Syrian oil Company, a Baathist (partisan); [redacted] employee at the health directorate, neutral; [redacted] employee at the Public Housing Corporation, neutral. His sisters: [redacted] married, and employed at the Syrian Oil Company, neutral; [redacted] housewife and neutral. His parental uncles: [redacted] a retired army veteran, a Baathist (active); [redacted] deceased. Maternal uncles: [redacted] neutral; [redacted] neutral.

It has not been established that any of his immediate family members or relatives is detained or wanted on political grounds.
