Circular

We have received the following information:

Intense daily meetings of the Salafi movement are taking place in northern Lebanon, including Tripoli and Akkar. Key political figures from the Future Movement and its allies attend these meetings to provide financial assistance and weapons to terrorists inside Syria through Wadi Khalid area as well as to receive their wounded and family members in Akkar. Armed people of different nationalities are in Akkar after entering Lebanon illicitly; they receive trainings in camps in Akkar (Wadi Mishmish) before being sent to Syria funded by the GCC through the Saudi Embassy in Beirut.

Information shows that figures from the Syrian opposition were spotted in Ar-Rahma mosque, at Qubbah Alley, in Tripoli (these mosques are affiliated with the Salafis). Some of them [redacted] were identified; a large number of Syrian fugitives were accommodated in flats especially rented for them near the mosque as they show up at night to attend instigative seminars against Syria.

Information indicates that a recent weapon cache has recently arrived to Akkar alongside some militants by sea.
